






Town of Fox Lake Recycling Instructions





Residents who do not have curbside garbage pickup may bring these items listed below to the Fox Lake Town Hall at W 10543 Hwy F.

|  <p>Aluminum</p> | Cans, Pie Pans, Foil, Bottle Caps, and Food Containers | Rinse Clean Crush | |
|  <p>Tin and Steel Cans</p> | Food Cans Only | Remove Labels Rinse Clean Remove Ends Flatten | Cardboard-Sided Juice Cans, Aerosol Cans, Paint and Paint Thinner Cans, Petroleum Cans |
|  <p>Plastic</p> | Milk, Soda, Detergent, Liquor, Pill, Shampoo, and Hair Spray All Bottles Marked:  | Rinse Clean, Remove and Discard Lids, Crush Bottles | Yogurt, Ice Cream, Margarine, Cottage Cheese Containers, Styrofoam, Plastic Cups, Bags, Film, Hard Plastic (Pails, Toys), Plastic Petroleum, Anti-Freeze Bottles, Medicine Bottles, Syringes |

*****Recycling Center operating schedule is each Saturday from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.

*****Place recyclable items in proper drums or containers.

*****For assistance an attendant is available during operating hours.

|  <p>Newspapers</p> | Newspapers, Office Paper, Flyers | Tie with String or Twine in Bundles Keep Dry | Books, Catalogs and Heavy Magazines |
|  <p>Corrugated Cardboard</p> | Large Boxes | Flatten Boxes Cut to 3'x3' Pieces Tie in Bundles | Cereal & Cracker Boxes Detergent Boxes Waxed Cardboard |
|  <p>Waste Oil</p> | Engine or Motor Oil | Transport to Recycling Center & Empty Transport Container into Collection Drum and Reuse Transport Container | Paint, Anti-Freeze and other Non-Petroleum-Based Liquids |
|  <p>White Goods Scrap Metal</p> | Refrigerators, Freezers, Ranges, etc. Heavy Iron, Brass, Copper, etc. Lawn Mowers, Iron Bed Springs | Read Footnote Below for Time and Place of Spring and Fall Recycling ***** | China Toilets and Sinks, Television Sets, Wood and Shingles |

***** (White Goods) Special pickup is held twice each year on the week following Memorial Day and the week following Labor Day. Residents having individual garbage pickup will have white goods picked up at curbside. All other residents may bring their whites goods to the Town Hall.
